The polar bear is the largest carnivorous mammal which lives on the ice around the North Pole, bordering the Arctic Ocean





Perfectly adapted to its habitat, the polar bear has a thick layer of fat and a fur to protect it from the cold. The white color of its coat gives it a perfect camouflage on the ice and its black skin allows the polar bear to better trap the heat from the sun. It is equipped with a short tail and small ears it has a relatively small head and an elongated body so it's well adapted to swim.
