


Stick Insects are herbivorous. They live mostly on their food: brambles, small fruit trees. They can also eat parsley.

The stick insect is very well adapted to its environment because:

- It moves very slowly, like a leaf blown by the wind.
- The stick insect can remain motionless for hours.





- It looks like a stick which is a good camouflage. For its predators this insect is very difficult to see through vegetation.
